

OUR Strategy



the context

The past 18 months have been some of the most tumultuous of our lives. We have faced a global pandemic, unrest and insecurity across the globe, and even a threat to our democracy in the United States. After decades of progress, the absolute number of people living in extreme poverty rose for the first time since 1997, primarily due to Covid-19. While much of the long-term effects of the pandemic on poverty are still unknown, the World Bank estimates that Covid-19 led to 97 million more people being in poverty in 2020. While 2021 saw improvements overall, in the poorest countries of the world, the impact of Covid-19 on poverty is worsening.

Meanwhile, existing challenges have continued-climate change, HIV, poverty and more. In August, the latest Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change Report provided a dire warning to the world - some changes already in motion are irreversible in our lifetimes. With strong, sustained action, we can still make an impact, but we must act now. A September 2021 report from The Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria revealed the devastating impact of Covid-19 in 2020, with significant declines in prevention, testing and treatment of HIV and TB.

As the pandemic has raged on, we have seen a rise in racism and xenophobia around the world, misinformation and disinformation campaigns, and government leader's grip on power tightens under the guise of controlling the pandemic. Within the international development sector, we have grappled with the decolonization of aid and our own role in how structural racism perpetuatess the cycle of poverty.

The world has been changed by Covid-19, and we must adapt to the new reality.

building on 50 years of impact

For the past half-century, Pact has always been dedicated to one promise: **improving the**

lives of people around the globe who are affected by poverty and marginalization, and doing it in a way that enables them to overcome challenges on their own. Today, our work reflects this promise more than ever, as Pact continues to lead the way in international development programming that puts local communities first and is carried out in true partnership with those we serve. We are a recognized global leader in creating social impact. Our programming helps communities combat HIV and AIDS, gain electricity, build peace and democracy, fight poverty through entrepreneurship, protect local natural resources, adapt to climate change, stop child labor and human rights abuses and much more. We are proud to have reached millions of people across more than 60 countries and to have made lasting change hand in hand with thousands of communities and partners.

PACT'S ORGANIZATIONAL PERFORMANCE INDEX

A pioneer and innovator in what is now among the most critical disciplines in international development, Pact has been strengthening groups and communities around the world for 50 years. A foundational, evidencebased approach to capacity development at Pact is the Organizational Performance Index (OPI). The OPI is a USAID-endorsed approach for measuring performance improvement of partners. Modelled on global standards, the tool measures performance of

organizations in the four domains of effectiveness, efficiency, relevance and sustainability, and is a gold standard for measuring organizational performance.
